



DETAILED ITINERARY (NON-SA CITIZENS) | Tosca | North West | South Africa |

DAY 1:

Clients will be met and welcomed upon arrival at OR Tambo International by management that may be accompanied by your professional hunter(s), who will be holding a sign with your name on it as you enter the arrivals lounge. From here the safari travels to the hunting camp, which is located in the bushveld. Travel time to Blanco Safaris from O.R Tambo International airport, Johannesburg is around five hours. In the event of flight arrivals anytime after 14h00 clients will be driven to Molopo private nature reserve, Molopo Eye - being a three hours drive situated near Lichtenburg, North West that is on route to Blanco Safaris to overnight and depart first thing in the morning.

Clients are met upon arrival at OR Tambo International Airport in Johannesburg and are returned there upon completion of the safari.

Accommodation is in bush rustic luxury chalets where all modern amenities are available. Meals are of the highest standard and a large variety of alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages are available and included. The success rate on the trophies is close to 100%. If, however, you do not take one of the trophies which is included in the package, 90% of the list price of the trophy is deducted from your hunting safari price. A deposit of 20% is payable upon booking your hunting package. The balance is payable upon completion of the safari.

HUNTING BUSHVELD:

Your days are devoted to hunting in the bushveld after all administrative paperwork, sighting of arms at shooting range and detailed discussions are made on proceeding including expectations of the client(s). The landscapes ranges from open stretches of grassland to dense vegetation ideal for the "walk & stalk" hunting practices across 2650 hectares. Blanco Safaris encourages sound and ethical hunting practices. Your hunting tour will be accompanied by qualified professional hunter(s) and or outfitter(s) from the region as required by law.

At this point the owner would have familiarized the surrounding areas with its potential hunting opportunities. If required some species can be hunted off-site in surrounding locations. The minimum duration of a hunting package is six days with a maximum stated on selected package.

Species which are available in the Bushveld area include:

Blesbok (Common), Blesbok (White), Blue Wildebeest, Black Wildebeest, Golen Wildebeest, Kings Wildebeest, Warthog, Bushbuck, Common Reedbuck, Eland, Gemsbok, White Gemsbok, Giraffe, Common Duiker, Impala, Jackal, Klipspringer, Kudu, Nyala, Ostrich, Red Hartebeest, Sable Antelope, Steenbok, Caracal, Serval, Tsessebe, Warthog, Waterbuck, Burchell's Zebra.

HUNTING AREAS, CAMPS & LODGES:

The hunting areas in the bushveld is 2500+ hectares on two farms. Our primary focus is ensuring that you take the trophies which are included in your safari. We make a determination on which farm to use based on current conditions prior to the starting date of your safari.

Our success rate is very close to 100%. In all cases the camps and lodges we use are luxurious with en suite bathrooms, electricity, stylish decoration and sumptuous food - places where families acting as observers would also feel at home and comfortable. Each of the camps and lodges we use feature on our website in the lodging - Chalet camp section.

We can provide an extensive list of references in your area who have hunted with us and who can bear testament to the quality of accommodation.

A TYPICAL DAY

HUNTERS:

A typical hunting day starts just before dawn at which time coffee and rusks are enjoyed. A selection of breakfast cereals, yogurt and juice is also available at this time. We then embark on the morning hunt. We normally hunt until about 11:00 at which time we return to the camp for brunch (a full meal which is a combination of breakfast and lunch). Some time is then devoted to relaxing in the camp. The hunt is resumed at about 14:30 and continues until sunset.

The method of hunting employed depends on the preference of the client and can consist of either walking and stalking, hunting from blinds or special vantage points from which we glass and ambush animals.

The option of hunting from one of our well-equipped vehicles is also available should you have any medical problems, or are limited by not being able to walk long distances. Your Professional Hunter will discuss these options with you after arrival. All of these options are always available. It is not necessary to let us know which method you prefer prior to your arrival.

ACTIVITIES.

Blanco Safaris is situated in a very remote region that offer little attractions - thus a great deal of activities has been made available on-site such as:

- Satellite television lounge with a selection of DVD's.
- Exotic game viewing (Blanco Game Ranch)
- Volley ball, cricket sports activities.
- Billiards and throwing darts.
- Bird watchers locations.
- swimming pool access.
- Various board games.
- Sundowners.
- Clay pigeon.
- Walking trails.
- Video games.

INCURSIONS:

In regards to incursions management will discuss this in great detail taking into account the needs of the clients. Due to Blanco Safaris remote locality it is best departure time for a chosen incursion be around the final days of booking as this would involve travelling to the inner parts of South Africa thus closer to Johannesburg making departure day logistics more efficient. Incursion concepts are:

- Golf club at Lichtenburg and sleep over at Molopo private nature reserve.
- Lost city - Sun City. This would require at least one day for traveling.
- Wildlife reserve for big 5 game viewing, requires at least one day for traveling.

OBSERVERS:

Observers are welcome to accompany the hunters on safari or relax in the camp. Should the observers in your group be interested in visiting some of the highlights in the area while the hunters are in the field, this can be arranged at an additional charge per day. The additional cost is incurred as we need to send a dedicated guide and vehicle to attend to the observers.

DEPARTURE:

As mentioned the drive back to O.R Tambo International airport, Johannesburg is around five hours. A detailed meeting on proceedings will take place the last morning in the wilderness. Proceedings may vary from client to client but the core value here is the needs of the clients, which is always placed first. All will be planned to suite your schedule and get done all that needs doing to ensure clients are transferred to the airport on time where their memorable African hunting safari ends.

Clients are welcome to take trophies in addition to those in your package, should the opportunity present itself.
