By Air

Tap on desired airport below to access its travel plan to Blanco Hunting Safaris main gate.

10km to main entrance. This airstrip is treated as fly-in-and-out. It has no security or personnel. Requires visual inspection before use.

Currently no air charter (unless private) serves this region directly. Land travel required to reach us from O.R Thambo or Mafikeng (Mmabatho) international airport after fly-in.

All land travel to Blanco Safaris must be done to supplied DMZ -25.871667, 24.077083 or DMS 25° 52'18.0"S 24°04'37.5"E or drop point ([Instant Messaging coordinates](#)) - that is to our main gate called **Blanco Safaris Entrance** on E.g Google Maps, it can also be found some distance below Blanco Safaris actual location when viewing us on a web mapping service. **Please do not travel to Blanco Safaris actual location on a web mapping service as these roads are largely unmapped and will result in you getting lost.**

Travel Advisory.

Due to our remote region it is one of the main reasons that we offer overnight accommodation as part of our services. It is to be noted the municipal and internal roads at Blanco Safaris are gravel roads (loose sand patches).

Although Blanco Safaris maintains its internal roads regularly the same cannot be said for the municipal roads as the condition varies a lot due to the heavy interlinks traffic daily.

It is highly recommended medium to high axle vehicles be used that are off-road, 4x4 or 4x2 enabled to navigate the terrain.

Please be on the lookout for stray wildlife in and crossing the roads to Blanco Safaris.

Travel advice to this region

While most parts of the country are perfectly safe for tourists to visit, it's important that visitors take precautions. For example, walking alone in deserted streets, and exposing expensive equipment and jewellery is not recommended. If you're in doubt as to the safety of a particular area or attraction, contact the National Tourism Information and Safety Line on +27 (0) 831232345. This number may also be used for assistance in replacing lost documents or reporting incidents.

Health & safety

Blanco Hunting Safaris is situated in a malarial and yellow fever free area. Closest private medial facilities are in Vryburg 183km away for emergencies - it is strongly advised that infants below the age of three, people with chronic sensitivity to temperatures, allergies, hay fever (seasonal), dust, high and low blood pressure not be included. Most living spaces have elevated foundations to keep wildlife out, with the assistance of another wheel chair bound people can easily navigate up - it is to be noted the terrain is mostly loose sand.

About the climate

Summer (September – March) usually brings high temperatures (approx. 19 – 38°C / 66 – 100°F) and seasonal rains. Winter (May – August) is drier, with invariably sunny days that begin and end with noticeably cooler temperatures (as low as approx. 5 – 24°C / 41 – 80°F).

What to pack

Warm clothing is recommended for the cooler months, and light clothing for summer. Choose neutral colours rather than bright or white clothing, and avoid wearing camouflage while travelling in Africa and border regions in South Africa. Access a downloadable suggested packing list [here](#).

Cell phone coverage for Vodacom is good (2G/3G), other cell operators has scattered or poor reception on property.

Reception, has a signal booster and Wi-Fi that can be used for transactional purposes and emergencies.
